## Our club's Yorkshire Figaro Rally 2017 outshone even California in the category Best Club Run/Rally at the Classic Car Show awards on 10th November at the NEC.

The calibre of our annual rally caught the attention of the Classic  $\vartheta$  Sports Car magazine award judges, overtaking shortlisted contenders including TVR and the Sunbeam Tigers tour to the sunshine state.

In June, 120 members of the club from the UK and Europe travelled to the Yorkshire Dales for the rally, which ran as smoothly as the 59 vintage engines. Our colourful convoy made its way up and down the dales for 4 days following a route and packed itinerary planned by Yorkshire yellow Figaro owner, Jane Ellison-Bates. The rally showcased the Yorkshire Dales National Park, taking in parts of Wharfedale, Nidderdale, Coverdale, Wensleydale, Littondale, Malhamdale, Ribblesdale and The Three Peaks.

The Classic Car Show fills five exhibition halls at the NEC, with 253 clubs exhibiting and competing for the prestigious annual awards. Collecting the Best Club Run/Rally award at the ceremony, Jane Ellison-Bates was thrilled to have the rally acknowledged among its classic car peers. She commented:

"Six months of largely sleepless nights in the planning was all worthwhile, but ultimately none of it would happen without the tireless support of our club founder, Kevin Fagan and the funloving, enthusiastic Figaro friends that come together to make the rallies rather special. The Yorkshire Dales are a perfect backdrop for driving the cars and it was a joy to show off this wonderful landscape."

Kevin was equally delighted with the award which followed our success in winning the Best Club Magazine award at the show in 2015. "We thought we might be in with a chance when the judges contacted us a few days before to offer us tickets to the awards and asked for a high resolution image of the rally, but it was still a great surprise as with such stiff competition we had thought we would be runners-up".

"Now the best thing for any old car – or not so old car, in fact – is to use it and there were several excellent entries for the Best Club Run/Rally. We were impressed by the TVR Car Club's Back Home, New Home tour – taking in Blackpool, of course, and the firm's new base in south Wales – and loved the idea of the Sunbeam Tiger Owners' Club's California tour. They marked 50 years since the end of Tiger production by shipping six cars to the States for an epic 1700-mile route that took in Laguna Seca and San Francisco.

Our winner, though, was much closer to home, through some of Britain's most breathtaking scenery – and organised by a one-model club with a really enthusiastic following. This brilliantly organised long weekend comprised various drives – up hill and down dale – of 40 to 80 miles. Not that challenging for relatively modern cars, you might think, but some of the 59 cars taking part had come from the continent. And they're all getting on for 30 years old. The main draw, though, was the spectacular Yorkshire Dales National Park, which about half of those taking part had never visited before.

## FIGARO RISES FROM THE ASHES

A £200 purchase led to a major re-fit including; engine, gearbox & pedal box Words & Pictures Colin Palmer

bought a Figaro from Japanese car auctions in 2005 - a few years later ,when driving my Figaro, I met a guy that works in a local paint shop and he told me there was a Figaro in the Nissan garage in Cirencester that they couldn't repair. So I went to see this unrepairable car, it was

outside in amongst a pile of tyres with engine and gearbox ( auto) removed.

I saw the boss who told me a lady from Stroud owned it, she had driven without water or oil and wrecked the engine, they couldn't get a new engine and the car was deemed unrepairable. I offered £1000 as it was but this was turned down. A few years later (2010 ?) the Nissan garage went bankrupt so I went to see the receiver and asked what was happening to the Figaro, he knew nothing about it so I showed it to him. still under pile of tyres, in a dreadful state with passenger window broken and very wet inside - all the engine components were in the car on the floor and seats, with turbo missing but radio CD still there.

l offered the receiver £200 as the car was and he accepted it, a mate and l got it on a trailer and it sat in my drive awaiting attention. First job was a window glass to keep rain out, l took all seats and trim out and this went in conservatory to dry out, it smelt a bit!!!!!

In the meantime I went to a breaker I know in Cheltenham and asked him to look out for a decent K10 micra so I could have the engine and gearbox and all the other bits I needed, things like pedal box and drive shafts. He phoned me a couple of months later with 1989 K10 micra with 49,000 miles on clock and a five speed gearbox for £150, I removed what I needed and he scrapped the rest of the car. So the conversion started, all the bolt holes were in the Figaro so no major work was required to get engine and gearbox fitted ,the most difficult job was the pedal box ,going from two pedals to three pedals- I kept all the K10 micra engine electrics so bypassed any of the original Figaro electrics, in all it took a few months to get the engine fitted and running, the seats and trim were all cleaned and re-fitted. I took it for an MOT and it passed with flying colours! At that stage I had two Figaros in my drives.

–A lady saw the two cars and took a liking to the one I had bought at auction, made me an offer that was much more than I paid for it, so I ended up with one Figaro with a manual gearbox.

That was 6 years ago and the Figaro is still going well !!!





I first came across 'Oliver' by chance through work in January 2016. He had been sitting on a driveway for 3 years unused, but not unloved. A deal was done (Jackie had turned down a higher bid for Oliver, but the car would have been stripped for parts - I did say earlier that he was loved) and he became mine. Oliver came without a key, a mouldy interior, seized brakes and rotten arches and bumpers but I finally owned a Figaro, a car I'd admired for many years.

The first thing I did was join the Figaro's Owners Club, whose font of knowledge has been invaluable. The first thing I needed to know was how to find the key code and after removing the door lock barrel I got a key cut. I replaced the battery and remarkably Oliver started first time.

My luck with Oliver continued with a chance meeting with Pete from Yorkshire Figaro's whilst looking for bumpers. A few weeks later Oliver

was trailered down to Rotherham for Pete to start the restoration. As you can see from the photos, Oliver was in a sorry state after standing for so lona

The list of jobs needed to get Oliver up and running was long, but this didn't faze Pete. The usual rust in the rear wheel arches and inner and outer sills all needed replacing with fresh steel. New brakes all round, rear shock absorbers, water pump and all the engines belts replaced as well as replacing some of the very hard to find chrome were just a few of the jobs Pete did. He also put in a new alarm system with central locking and new speakers. The car was then waxoyled to protect all the new metalwork and the back half of the car resprayed.

Pete did the most amazing work and he treated Oliver like he was his own car. I got regular updates and lots of photos of the work he was doing, always with the comforting caveat of 'it's not as bad as it looks'. I know he did a lot more work than he charged me for and his advice was always welcome.

Oliver finally got a new MOT in April 2016 and had a new number plate – FIG 9995 – to celebrate. It was an absolute joy to drive him home to Middlesbrough.

With apologies to the purists, the polo wheels have been changed for alloys as I prefer the look of them. With the help of my son, we refurbished them along with the radiator grill and cleaned up the interior.

As is always the case, the work hasn't stopped there. Since Oliver returned home, I've had the steering rack replaced along with the lower wishbones and a re-cored radiator and all the hoses replaced, all by a local garage – Barron Motors, who again have been fantastic. They even researched how to tune the engine to make him run better. Just as Pete at Yorkshire Figaro's did, Barron Motors really have taken Oliver to their heart. Driving Oliver always puts a huge smile on my face and he always gets admiring looks. However, the best part of owning Oliver is the reaction of my kids - Joe, Adam and Emma. I'm still an uncool dad, but I'm an uncool dad with a really nice car.

My thanks go to Jackie for selling me Oliver and having the trust that I would get him on the road again. To Pete at Yorkshire Figaro's for all the love and work he put into restoring Oliver. he Figaro is famous for its cute design and the wheels are no small part of this. The stunning curved body with its unique 'polo' style wheel sets the car apart from any other made.

In this article I want to pass on any knowledge I have regards the different designs, styles and also the practical implications of changing wheels. After all since these cars were first produced enthusiasts have been customising them and it's always good to have all the information if your considering doing this.

#### Original Wheels

With the original cars there was standard wheel type plus one option. The Polo wheel was the standard and was on over 90% of the cars. Its a two part wheel trim with the chrome centre cap and the plastic outer Polo finisher. Most people we meet love this design and we often find people who replace their wheels have a longing to revert back to the classics.

The option wheel was to fit the Chrome centre alloy wheel. The size of the wheel is the same as the steel rim/polo trim set up but is a completely different style.

Some owners like these more, some less, either way they are a factory option and the car drives equally well with these or the polo rim. If you decide to buy a set of these option wheels, and find some without the chrome centre caps it's worth noting that although the centre cap looks very similar to the original chrome centre cap these extremely rare parts are a different shape. The polo style caps won't sit correctly on the alloy wheels.

Another thing that's worth noting when it comes to the original wheels is the tyres condition. We probably advise owners about perishing on 20% of the cars we service. What seems to happen with the Figs is that the tyres don't actually wear out regarding the tread but the rubber starts to perish. It's not unusual for us to find tyres that are 15 years old. For some tyres that's well past their working life and they are starting to split and crack. Even if they have barely been used. In the video link below..



#### Changing to custom wheels

Figaro owners love to customise and many of these great cars have had alloy wheels fitted for many years. There are lots of choices in the same stud fitment and so you can really express your taste this way. The nice things about completely custom wheels is that you can completely change the style of the car without making permanent changes.

There are a few issues that come with fitting these aftermarket wheels though. Firstly the sizes are very rarely the same as the originals. They are usually bigger, in diameter and width.

The first major hurdle is if they will actually fit in the wheel wells, we have seen wheels rubbing on the chassis or bodywork on a few occasions and it leaves it pretty messy as well as making noises. These oversize wheels often causes poor handling. Usually this manifests itself by causing a slightly notchy feel at the steering wheel, almost as if the wheels are not completely round. The car doesn't seem to turn as smoothly and this issue is usually noticeable when the wheel is turned slightly.

Bigger wheels are also putting more wear on the steering parts so wear that out a little quicker too.

*"If you're considering a change it's also worth keeping your original polo wheels and trims. They are hard to find used and very expensive new. We meet owners who bought their car with custom wheels and are then going through the process of trying to change it all back which can be a long haul"* 

In the end none of these issues are things you can't live with, I'm firmly of the belief that your car should be an extension of your imagination so enjoy customising your Figs! If you would like any further advice just let us know, we are happy to help.






#### Instrument Meter Lights LED Upgrade

If you've driven your Figaro in the dark and the lighting on both the Speedometer  $\vartheta$  Tachometer is poor, the chances are it still contains the original tungsten bulbs. Due to the age of the car these can become blackened over time.

#### The technical reason why the bulbs go black?

When you turn on the lights, the tungsten filament inside the light bulb is heated white hot. After hours at this high temperature, some of the metal "boils off" just like steam from water. The glass container of the bulb is cooler than the metal, so the metal vapour condenses out, again like steam on a window. As the metal boils away, the filament gets thinner and thinner until it breaks. The black colour is a thin layer of tungsten metal on the glass.

The result of this is poor lighting which is very hard to read. The solution is to replace the bulbs but it makes much more sense to upgrade the latest LED's (light-emitting diodes) as these use less current, are shock proof and last much longer. To do this, you will need to remove the meters to gain access to the bulbs on the rear, remove each bulb and replace with an LED replacement.

- Light Colour: White (although you can choose other colours)
- LED Type: 5050 SMD
- Base Type: T5 Neo Wedge
- Base Dimater: 12mm
- Working Voltage: 12V DC





The specification for the restoration on this fantastic car is what's known as sympathetic, its not our popular full rolling restoration and is not as in depth. The reason for this is that when you have a survivor car like this one its condition is as it was in 1991. Everything you change will never be the same again. Its only like this once and every time you remove something, even every time you use the car, it changes. Its almost like a snapshot in time that can never be replicated again, like a piece of moving art! Its such a pleasure to look at and work on.

The mechanical changes made were all to make sure the car performs well in the Florida heat. The re cored radiator, the cooling hoses. Up rated ignition leads were fitted, we went through the car and got all the servicing and cambelt up to date. The car still has its original tyres, and they are like new!

The inside of the car was trimmed in stunning soft hides of leather. The dashboard, steering wheel, gearshift, handbrake and armrests were all finished in the same hide of brown leather. A contrasting ivory hide was used to re cover the seats with new foam and piping from the brown used on the dash. Even the inside of the glove box is lavished in this luxurious material. With puddle lighting, full Dynamat insulation and handmade carpeting throughout the car and boot this is amazing place to sit.

The engine bay was detailed to an incredibly thorough level. With the mounting brackets being either re plated or re finished. The inner wings were painted to a lacquered finish and the engine components re-plated, blasted and then re coated the engine bay on this car is an absolute show winner. Such a fantastic thing to look at were so proud of it.
