




OWNER WORKSHOP

Coolant System and Hoses Information

THE FIGARO'S ARE OVER 23 YEARS OLD NOW, WITH AGE BRINGS THE LIKELIHOOD OF PARTS FAILURE IF NOT PROPERLY MAINTAINED.

A common failure are the hoses in the coolant system. With age these can crack and then split allowing engine coolant to be lost. When coolant is lost the engine temperature can't be maintained and will continue to raise uncontrolled. If the car is driven further in this state the results can be catastrophic to the engine.

Damage will normally be to the top of engine called the head which can warp or crack with the extreme heat, this will then need removing and pressure testing and if not cracked it will normally require skimming which is a machining processes to remove a layer of metal to create a completely flat surface again. Refitting will need an new Figaro specific head gasket. However further areas of damage can occur and

should be properly checked; the pistons and rings can melt and in turn damage the cylinders. Therefore overheating can result in a very expensive repair or worse result in a replacement engine being required.

The cooling system performance can be impaired over time by becoming blocked. It is recommended the full system especially the radiator be fully flushed both ways. The cooling system is around 4 litres. It is recommended to use a 50% mix of 50% mixture of ethylene glycol antifreeze with distilled water. Antifreeze comes in different colours normally determine its life eg: 2 or 5 years. Waterless coolant is also available, however this is normally only used on high performance cars.

The Nissan hoses are standard and not silicon. The standard shaped hoses can be replaced with standard silicon ones, however I've not seen a full set of silicon ones.

It is recommend replacing old hose clips with good quality "Jubilee" type clips to reduce the likelihood of any failure. Although I haven't specifically listed the water pump, it is recommended that this be replaced at the same time as all the cam-belt and associated parts.



Club Member Chris Towers talks to Figgyworld

My wife and I bought this Figaro as a present for our elder daughter in 2005. It had just been imported by a company in North Yorkshire. When she got married and moved abroad, she wanted to sell the car so we bought the car back from her – the only car I have bought twice in my life. It then got used by my wife on sunny days.

My main hobby is restoring and rallying classic cars.
Consequently I look after this car myself – even have a car lift in my workshop to make things a lot easier.

In 2009, a friend I do quite a few classic car rallies with, Tom Callanan, asked if I fancied doing the Tour Britannia with him in a 1967 Vauxhall Viva GT that he had just acquired. The Tour Britannia is an event that takes all competitors around race tracks and stately homes over a

Silverstone Race Circuit and finish in Harrogate. Tom, living in Dublin, had to bring the Viva over on a trailer to the start. He had arranged for some friends to transport his tow car and trailer to Harrogate. Because I had to get myself to and from the event by car, I thought it would make sense to get my car transported from the start to the finish as well so I decided to take the Figaro as it was the smallest car I had that would fit on his trailer.

The first circuits on the event were the Silverstone Race Track and the new (then) Porsche Test Track. Sadly, the Viva's engine blew up on the Porsche Test Track. We got towed back to the pits then put the car on the trailer and drove back to the overnight hotel in the Figaro, where we parked it alongside all the other competitors.

These events are not cheap to do, and we didn't really want to do

new set of rally plates and stickers and put them on the car – they didn't actually know what a Figaro was. So, on the next morning Tom drove the car to the start control, with me as co-driver, to everyone's absolute amazement! Following a run round the tracks of Cornbury Park, we then set off to Rockingham Speed Circuit. The marshals at Rockingham all cheered when we started buzzing round there in the company of all the other fast competitors. Tom and I had smiles on our faces all the way round – we just couldn't believe we were actually doing it.

We then went to other venues such as Belvoir Castle and Cadwell Park. At the end of the Figaro's first day out, all our fellow competitors dragged us into the bar to exchange stories of us hairing round with them during the day especially when we had the roof down for most of the time

The last day took us to places like Olivers Mount in Scarborough, Castle Howard and finally Harewood Hill Climb near Harrogate. EXPERT TOBY BROOKS TALKS TO FIGGYWORLD ABOUT RUST!

When the Owners Club asked me to write an article using a case study from our workshops I wanted to describe something that many owners don't see, even when the work is carried out on their own 'Fig'.

I decided it would be good for owners to know what went on when their car has this 'open heart surgery'. Although its not the most glamorous diagnosis, there is no denying the fact that some Figgys do suffer with rust! One of the hardest areas for us to describe, and to warrant the cost of repair, is rust on the sills.

Figaro sills are formed in complicated shapes, the layers of box sections press together in order to create the strongest structural integrity. On convertibles especially this is very important.

When an owner comes to us with their cherished Figaro, looking for restoration or paintwork, they nearly always leave with a huge smile, sometimes even tears. That's a great part of our job. The slightly disappointing thing from our point of view is that with sills which have been restored the car still looks the same, runs the same, it may on the surface seem that the MoT and invoice are the main achievements!

So I hope this article will encourage you to see the beauty in all restoration, even the barely visible parts.

With this in mind I hope to outline what we go through in order to make a sill repair in the correct way. These cases often begin with the Figgy owner bringing their car in for restoration, or perhaps the car is here already having failed an MoT on structural corrosion.

Once we have discovered that the sill is rusted our first task is to remove all the chrome trim; we need access. In severe cases we also need to remove the door.

Image 1 - You can see in the image the car before the chrome is stripped, this is the sill. It runs front to back and is the area you see when the door is open however its usually the out of sight areas which corrode.















Image 3 - You can see what nasty surprises are often lurking!

Image 4 -The first step to the sill repair is always to cut away the outer skin and inspect, sometimes its just this layer but in most cases it's more. In the images we are using the car needed 4 layers - the inner heel plate, part of the floor, the inner sill, and the outer sill. The inner sill helps to create the strength.

Image 5 - Here is the new sill taking shape, carefully cutting and spot welding this in place takes a lot of man hours.

Image 6 - Here is a sill repair panel before its cut up, the idea is to trim it to match the rusty area.

Image 7 - The metalwork has to be ground smooth, treated, stone chip protected and then painted.

Image 8 - The new sill is stone chip protected and then cavity waxed

Image 9 - You can see here whilst the sill is prepared for paint, it has already been stone chipped giving it the textured finish. A well crafted sill should look straight as though it has never been repaired. This sill will last for 10+ years.

Image 10 - Once complete there should be no trace of repair, the car is structurally sound and ready to enjoy again...(

THE WORLD ACCORDING TO BEEP BEEP

JOHN COOPER: Figaro nut and all round good egg lets his car 'Beep beep' talk to Figgyworld about the importance of daily checks

Being a Figaro comes with a multitude of daily challenges. Notwithstanding I'm getting on, having an owner that likes to push me to my limits adds more than my fair share of pressures.

Don't get me wrong. I love to go fast, otherwise why have a turbocharger? But I am a classic. I need looking after. Driving 40 miles straight on the motorway in excess of 4500 RPM doesn't just happen without knowing that everything that needs checking has been checked.

My oil is dipped, topped up if necessary. Brake and steering fluids are checked. Don't forget the washer bottle either. It doesn't help the engine, but it is part of a routine that should become a habit. The more time you spend under the bonnet, the less time a mechanic will have to.

Take the coolant for example. It's checked, but rarely topped up. But it's not just any coolant. It's Evans waterless coolant. That's right, there is no water in my engine.

Think of the engine as a big pressure cooker. You run the engine, it gets hot. When the water reaches boiling point, it turns to steam. That increases the volume, in turn increasing the pressures in the engine. Specifically, hoses and other components.

And because there is no water, there is no corrosion. That helps protect all of the parts like the radiator and water pump because there is no corrosion build-up.

It's not for everyone, but everyone should take that extra bit of time to make those checks. In case you were wondering, the tyre pressures are

rarely checked. That's because there is no air in them. Mine are full of nitrogen. I'll tell you about that next time.
