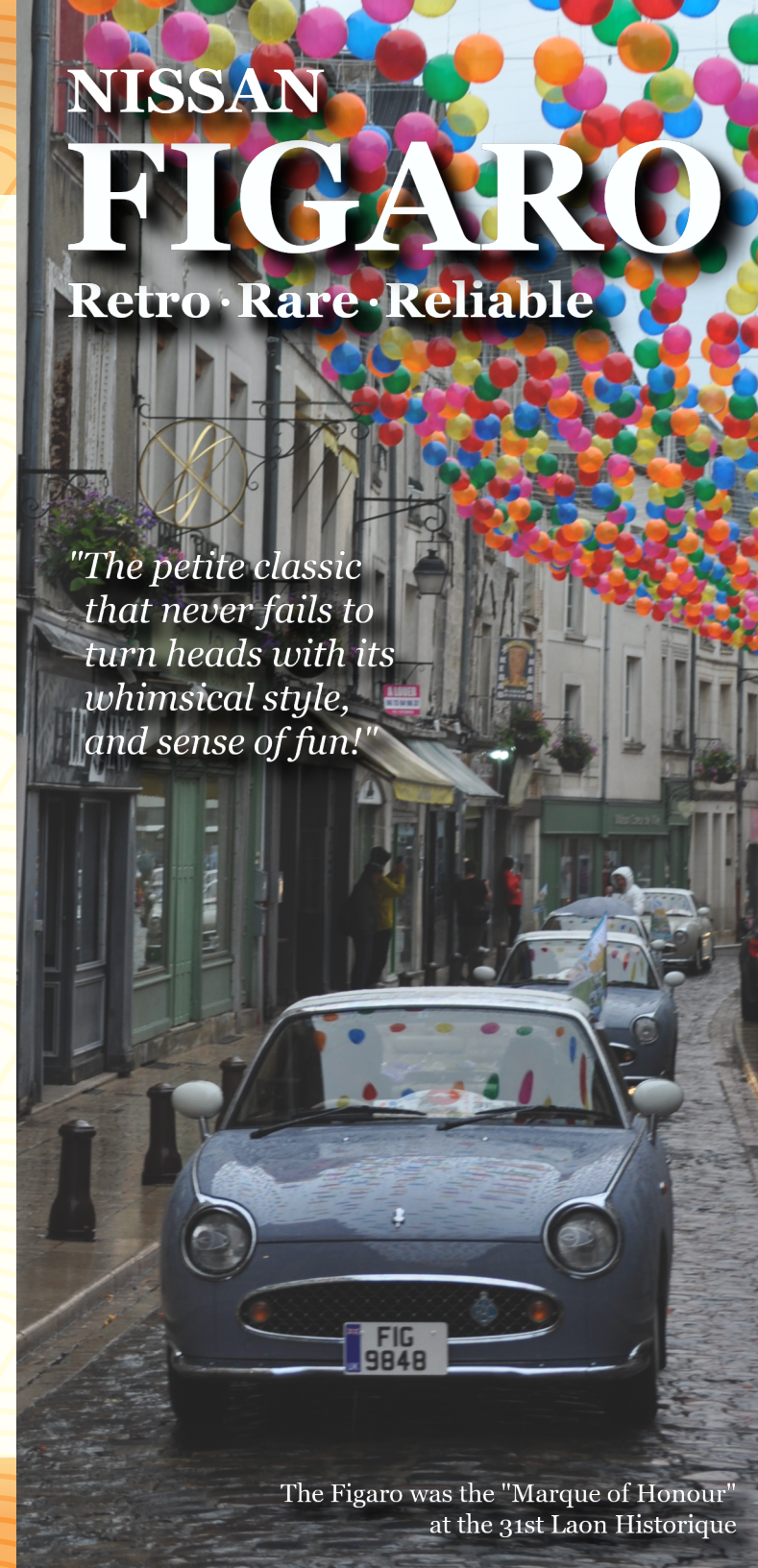

All about the NISSAN FIGARO



The Figaro first made its debut at the 1989 Tokyo Motor Show. Originally planned for a limited production run of just 8,000 units, due to tremendous demand Nissan decided to increase production to 20,000 and implemented a lottery system for potential buyers to win the chance to own this most special of cars.

Colours

The Figaro came in four pastel body colour options. Originally thought to be based on the seasons, a recent translation in 2020 revealed the colours were inspired by the beauty of gemstones. We still think that the seasons work quite nicely too!

Nissan's Figaro inspiration

In the late 1980s, Nissan was struggling with sales and commissioned a team of designers to take a fresh approach, designing cars based on people's lifestyles rather than what the manufacturer wanted. The "*Pike Factory*" produced four limited run vehicles, of which the Figaro was the low riding coupe with flower bud designs throughout commonly referred to as Fleur De Lys. Nissan's own brand appears but very discreetly.

Topless driving in an instant

The manual roof of the vehicle is designed with convenience and efficiency in mind. With just a few simple steps, it can be effortlessly dropped within seconds, allowing for an open-air driving experience.



Attention-grabbing

Owning a Figaro is an attention-grabbing experience that quickly becomes a part of daily life. This charming little car has the unique ability to bring a smile to the face of a passer-by, sparking their curiosity and leading them to want to know more. Figaro owners are often approached with questions like "*What is it?*" and "*Do they still make them?*". Being the current owner, and the latest in a long line of custodians of the car, it is a real privilege to share in the knowledge and passion of this iconic vehicle. Few cars spark joy and admiration as this quirky Japanese car from the 90s does, even if it is sometimes mistaken for a Fiat from the 50s.

How much do they cost?

Every Figaro is always at a stage of restoration, so prices can vary from £2,000 to over £25,000 for a pristine low mileage model. The majority typically sell for around £8,000.



Personalisation

There were 55 Original Accessories available to owners, to pick from, helping them to make the car their own. While some were quite practical, many are quite quirky and will often be quite the talking point. Some can still be found today, while others have been faithfully reproduced. Popular items include eye lids, cup holder, parking stick, net shelf, scuff cups and floor mats.

Maintenance & servicing costs

Regular servicing is crucial for the Figaro. Nissan advises every 6,000 miles. However, we believe that an annual service (costing around £250) is more realistic. You should be aware, that every four or five years the cam belt will require changing at a cost of around £350.
